Through INTEMPO’s Music School, almost 140 children — most from immigrant backgrounds — are learning one or more of the following instruments: violin, viola, cello, guitar, charango, piano, percussion, voice, and audio production. Our repertoire focuses on not only Western classical music but also music from our students’ cultural backgrounds.

Without the financial aid we offer, most of our families could not afford our tuition. Named scholarships will help us become tuition-free for every qualifying student, setting them up for musical, academic, and social emotional success.

Your IMPACT

Your scholarship will provide the following essential services for your student, empowering them to realize their full potential:

- › Their own instrument.
- › Small group classes and private lessons, depending on age and level.
- › Audition coaching for selective music programs like the Norwalk Youth Symphony and YOLA National Festival.
- › Performance opportunities in major venues like Stamford's Palace Theatre and Norwalk City Hall.
- › Literacy tutoring for at-risk students and drop-in homework help for all students.
- › Leadership development via our Youth Councils for middle- and high-school students.
- › College readiness via our College Prep Club.
- › Workforce development via paid internships with INTEMPO and community partners.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How can I donate?

You can donate \$250 monthly for three years, \$3K annually for three years, or \$9K all at once. We can help you set up automatic payments. This is a tax-deductible gift.

Can I name my scholarship after someone?

Yes, after yourself, a loved one, an amazing music teacher, or a role model — we encourage you to be creative!

Can I name multiple scholarships?

Yes. You can give them all the same name (for example, five Gonzalez Family Scholarships) or different names.

How will I be matched with a student?

We will choose the student who will most benefit from your scholarship; however, if you have a preference (for example, based on the age group, instrument, or other) we will do our best to accommodate you when possible.

What happens to my scholarship after three years?

You will have the option to renew your pledge and continue the scholarship.

What happens if my scholarship recipient isn't enrolled in your Music School for three years?

Our Music School has a high annual student retention rate of 92%. If your student cannot continue studying music with us, your scholarship will be reassigned to a different student who will greatly benefit.

Will I hear from my scholarship recipient?

You will receive a personal letter annually from them about their growth in our Music School.

Can I make a one-year pledge?

A three-year pledge is necessary to name a scholarship. If you can only commit to one year, your donation will provide significant support for our Music School.

What if my company does 1:1 matching?

If you pledge the full amount, your company will double your impact. Or you can pledge half the amount and your company will fulfill the other half.

Can a group of people create a named scholarship together?

Yes, you can create a pooled fund! For example, if you play in a bridge club with four other people, each of you can donate \$50 monthly to name the Tuesday Night Bridge Players Scholarship. Or the Every Other Wednesday String Quartet Scholarship!
